Position Summary

Greets every horsemen, friendly and outgoing. We are looking for efficient stable gate security to provide a safe and secure environment for horses being stabled at Wyoming Downs and ensure the restricted barn area rules and regulations or Wyoming Downs, the Wyoming Pari-mutuel Commission and the Wyoming Board of Livestock are adhered to. Ability to work in a fast paced environment on race days admitting horsemen and horses in a series of steps to process horses into the stabling area, provide information to horsemen and owners in a courteous and efficient manner; ensure only WPC licensed persons are granted access to the restricted area and refer horsemen to appropriate staff members or race office for parking passes and visitor passes. Advises horsemen of parking restrictions and parking areas on the backside. Be flexible in staffing location on race days as instructed by Department Supervisor. May include backside parking lot enforcement on race days.

The ideal candidates must have superior interpersonal skills; Ability to resolve problems/conflict in a diplomatic and tactful manner; Ability to work a variety of shifts including evenings, graveyard, weekends and holidays; Ability to stand or walk for long periods of time; Ability to read, write and communicate in English; Working knowledge of a variety of radio communication devices and small office equipment; Ability to walk on varying surfaces for extended periods, run when the situation requires.

Priority of the position is to ensure the safety and security of the backside procedures are followed as well as rules and regulations, providing high standards of customer service, courtesy and safety at all times. Ability to work cooperatively with other team members contributing to a positive work environment and communicate professionally with various departments and levels of management. Professional well-groomed appearance. Must be able to stand for long periods of time. Day and Swing positions pay \$100 per shift / Graveyard pay is \$110 per shift. Equal Opportunity Employer. Paid training. Seasonal employment only. Uniforms t-shirts are responsibility of employee. If WPC license is required a \$35 fee is deducted from first paycheck.
