## AQHVA RACING EXPERIENCE TRAINER'S SHEET

The following lists the concepts and/or skills we'd like the participants in the AQHYA Racing Experience to witness. This list can certainly be expanded, but we'd like to insure that all participants get the same basic curriculum.

### MANAGEMENT & ADMINISTRATION OF A RACING BARN

1. Learn about the routine of a "typical" day (racing and non-racing) at the racing stable, what goes on from the time the first person gets to the barn in the morning to the time when the last person leaves in the evening. This would include how many people it takes to run the barn and what their specific responsibilities are.
2. The expenses and revenue associated with owning or training a racehorse; what the owner pays for and what the trainer pays for. For your convenience, we have provided a worksheet on the following page.

### HORSEMANSHIP & TRAINING TECHNIQUES

1. Training issues:
  - What is involved in getting a two-year-old to its first race
  - How you keep the "veterans" in winning form
2. Identification of the equipment used in racing and training – bits, bridles, martingales, saddles, tongue ties, bandages, boots, blinkers, shadow rolls, etc. What they look like, what they are used for and how to fit them properly.
3. The proper way to bandage a leg for training, racing and in the barn
4. Your views and practices in the use of different therapies such as using ice, whirlpools, magnetic therapy, etc.
5. Where to find and how to read a tattoo
6. Shoes and shoeing for the racehorse
7. The feeding regime for horses of varying age and fitness. What supplements are used?
8. Etiquette on the racetrack. How does everyone stay out of each other's way in the morning?
9. The routine of the horse's day. We'd like each student to follow:
  - At least one horse through a "training" or non-racing day
  - At least one horse on the day that it is racing
