**\*\*Before arriving at Wyoming Downs Racetrack, all horses must have a current Health Certificate (within 30 days), negative Coggins, and Piroplasmosis tests within 12 months and brand inspection.**

## **Stall Application Terms and Conditions**

This stall application is a revocable license subject to the terms and conditions outlined herein. All stable reservations and entries in stakes and other races are received and accepted subject to all conditions, rules, and regulations of the Wyoming Gaming Commission and Wyoming Downs. The stall applicant ("Licensee") must completely fill out and sign the form below. No stable reservation or entry in any race will be received except upon the condition that all disputes, claims, and objections arising out of racing, or with respect to the interpretation of any rules or conditions of races or otherwise, shall be decided by the Wyoming Gaming Commission, the Board of Stewards, the Association, or Management, and such decisions shall be final.

Wyoming Downs ("Licensor") reserves the right to cancel any stakes race or other race prior to the actual running thereof, without liability, except for the return of nomination and entrance fees. Wyoming Downs further reserves the right to refuse entry in any race or admittance to the grounds to any person deemed detrimental to racing. Wyoming Downs reserves the right to produce or exhibit still or motion pictures, radio broadcasts, photographs, television programs, or to authorize others to make or exhibit the same of races and related events occurring prior to, during, and after the running of races.

The Licensee's acceptance of stall accommodations or the making of an entry in any race shall constitute an agreement of the following: (a) the applicant represents that he or she has secured like consent from the owner, jockey, groom, agents, and associates connected with the applicant's racing activities; and (b) agrees upon demand to provide Wyoming Downs with written consent from any such persons permitting the use and exhibition of such material.

It is a requirement that all horses listed on this application be in good health and be accompanied by the following prior to entry onto the grounds:

- A current Health Certificate issued within thirty (30) days of entry
- A negative Coggins Test
- A negative Piroplasmosis test within twelve (12) months
- A brand inspection, if applicable

Any horse not accompanied by complete and current health documentation will not be permitted entry to the grounds under any circumstances.

This application does not guarantee that stalls will be allotted, nor does it guarantee that tack rooms or walker space will be available. If tack room or walker space is requested, such request must be indicated in the appropriate section of the application.

**Workmen's Compensation:** Wyoming State Law requires that all owners and trainers carry Workers' Compensation Insurance covering all their employees. This requirement includes all individuals employed by owners and trainers in the training and racing of horses.

### **Barn Area Vehicle and Access Policy**

For the safety of horses, personnel, and the public, no passenger vehicles are permitted within the barn area during training hours or during hours of racing.

From 5:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. daily, only golf carts and small ATVs will be permitted in the barn area. On race days, no passenger vehicles will be permitted in the barn area beginning one (1) hour prior to first post and continuing through the conclusion of racing.

The only exceptions to this policy are licensed veterinarians, farriers, and authorized service vehicles, as approved by Wyoming Downs management. A designated horsemen's parking area and golf cart staging areas will be provided. Owners and trainers should plan accordingly, as the unrestricted vehicle access permitted in prior years will not be allowed during the 2026 racing season.

## **Stall and Tack Room Condition and Release of Papers**

As a condition of release and return of horse papers at the conclusion of stabling, all stalls and tack rooms assigned to the applicant must be fully cleaned and left in satisfactory condition. This includes the removal of all manure, bedding, hay, equipment, and debris.

Prior to the release or transfer of any horse papers, the stall superintendent must inspect the stalls and tack rooms and provide approval that they are in acceptable condition. Any stall not cleaned to satisfaction will result in a fine of \$150 per uncleaned stall, and any tack room not cleaned to satisfaction will result in a fine of \$200 per tack room.

All assessed fees must be paid in full. Any unpaid fees may be deducted from the trainer's or owner's horsemen's account. If sufficient funds are not available in the horsemen's account, the outstanding balance must be paid prior to the approval of any future stall applications and may result in the denial of stall privileges in subsequent racing seasons.

## **Important Notice**

In making this application for stalls, the signer agrees to stable and race approved horses during the entire season. If the signer intends to vacate allotted stalls and race elsewhere prior to the end of the season, the Racing Secretary must be notified at the time of application.

In consideration of the privilege of stabling on the premises of Wyoming Downs for the purpose of racing horses, the undersigned agrees to abide by all rules of Wyoming Downs pertaining to stabling, to vacate stalls upon request within three (3) days, and to hold Wyoming Downs harmless from any loss, injury, damage, liability, or attorneys' fees arising from stabling or racing activities, whether caused by negligence or otherwise. Wyoming Downs assumes no liability for loss of horses or equipment. Trainers and owners are encouraged to maintain appropriate insurance coverage.

## **Full Release**

Licensee agrees to protect, indemnify, defend and hold Licensor and its officers, directors, employees, agents, and Licensees, harmless from and against any and all third-party claims, demands, causes of action, damages, liabilities, fines and expenses, including reasonable attorneys' fees and costs (collectively "Claims"), that arise out of or are directly or indirectly related to (i) the performance of the Agreement by Licensee, (ii) Licensee's failure to comply with any obligations set forth in the Agreement, (iii) the damage or destruction of real or personal property or personal injuries (including death to any human or animal) to the extent caused by the acts or omissions of Licensee or any of its officers, directors, shareholders, employees, agents, Licensees, subsidiaries and affiliates (collectively, the "Licensee Parties"), (iv) the misconduct, reckless or negligent acts or omission of any of the Licensee Parties, (v) Licensee's failure to comply with applicable laws, regulations or orders, or (vi) any claim or cause of action by or on behalf of Licensee's employee(s), agents, representatives or sub-Licensees against Licensee relating to the performance of services on behalf of Licensee hereunder, including without limitation any claims for personal injury including Licensee's negligence, workers' compensation insurance or employment benefits, including those provided under the Affordable Care Act, or any claims under any federal, state or local employment laws or regulation. The parties acknowledge that the Licensee shall be solely responsible for all safety procedures, and compliance with OSHA and/or any other laws and ordinances. The Licensee's indemnity shall cover any matters arising as a result of its use of the premises and/or safety procedures since Licensor shall have no involvement with or responsibility therefore. This indemnity shall survive the termination of this License with respect to matters occurring during the period covered by this License Agreement. The obligations of this paragraph shall survive the expiration or termination of this Agreement. The Licensee represents that he or she and all persons for whom the signer is acting have read and are familiar with the Wyoming Downs Rules of Racing and the regulations of the Wyoming Gaming Commission, agree to be bound by and comply with the same, and acknowledge that the decisions of the Stewards and Racing Officials shall be final in all matters.
